## **85 percent of Smith/Norrell support came from South Carolinians in Q4**

COLUMBIA, S.C. – James Smith and Mandy Powers Norrell raised \$317,249.30 in the last quarter of 2018, for a total of \$3,143,494.09 over the year in their campaign for governor and lieutenant governor of South Carolina.

Of that, 84.98 percent came from South Carolina individuals and companies. Individuals accounted for 97.70% of the contributions made; the amount they gave was 69.42 percent of the total cash raised.

There were 1,997 contributions in the period. The average donation was for \$158.86. The period ran from Oct. 17-Jan. 10.

“Our campaign was powered by the people of South Carolina, from start to finish,” said Smith. “We remain humbled by the outpouring of support for our positive vision for our state.”

“The outcome wasn’t what we’d hoped for, but there is no doubt that there was and is wide support for the ideas we ran on,” said Rep. Norrell. “Thousands of South Carolinians stepped up and put their money where their hopes were.”

In the last quarter, the campaign spent \$661,251.40, for a total of \$1,871,782.07 in the general election period. Contributions in the general election totaled \$1,762,464.56.

Of the total contributions for the quarter, \$7,455.22 was in the form of in-kind contributions.
